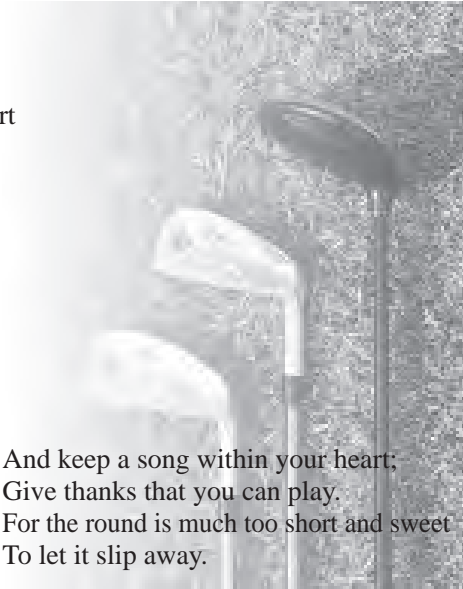

It was composed of multiple layers of granite, which when viewed from below, showed an almost perfect profile of a man. This much-loved profile is depicted on the official state seal, and even on auto license plates...and locally referred to as The Old Man.

As more settlers came into the area, the Indian foot path was widened to become a dirt wagon road. But the wagon road proved inadequate as automobiles became common and traffic increased. The next “improvement” was a two-lane paved road. But in time even it wasn’t enough to handle the tourist traffic which often slowed to a crawl through the Notch.


