Dear Members:

As you are aware, we are at a high risk for the recent outbreak of the COVID 19, corona virus which is the reason for this letter.

I, the Board & the Manager are asking you to understand we are erring on the side of caution here." ***Until further notice, WEG is halting all activities or upcoming events where members are congregating, even in smaller groups".***

We are taking seriously that all of us as residents living here and using our facilities are the "target" group this virus is attacking. Please understand that these actions are being taken for all our benefit. Please continue to follow the CDC guidelines for prevention:

- a. Wash hands frequently for 20 seconds and don't dry on a hand towel, use a paper towel
- b. Don't touch your face
- c. Stay away from groups of people whenever possible
- d. If you become ill call your Drs office about getting tested
- e. Always cover your mouth & nose if sneezing or coughing
- f. Order groceries delivered, don't go out unless necessary
- g. According to the CDC, being outside isn't any less of a risk

If WEG closes, all buildings including Country Cottage Restaurant will be locked, and the golf course will be closed as well. Signs will be posted notifying anyone that reads them that we are closed, and the community will be notified when it is safe again, for them, to open.

This is uncharted territory for us and the entire nation, so we're asking for your assistance in getting us through this "State of Emergency" and the magnitude this is anticipated to impact us.
